By-Law No. 2016-07

Being a by-law to enter into contract for insurance against risks that may involve pecuniary loss or liability on the part of the Board for the 2016-2017 fiscal year.

WHEREAS section 7(5) of the *Northern Services Board Act*, R.S.O. 1990, CHAPTER L.28 provides that the Board shall by by-law contract for insurance against risks that may involve pecuniary loss or liability on the part of the Board and provide for the payment of premiums therefore.

NOW THEREFORE the Local Services Board of Nolalu enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Local Services Board of Nolalu enter into contract with Frank Cowan Company Limited, through the insurance broker Philpot & Delgaty Limited, for the provision of insurance as per the 2016 General Insurance Program, as attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this by-law.
2. THAT the premium of \$1,620 for this contract shall be included in the 2016-2017 budget.

WHEREAS after the adoption of the 2016-2017 Budget, it was discovered that there are seven additional properties on the assessment roll than estimated; and

WHEREAS the additional properties result in an increased levy to be collected; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Finance requires that the by-law authorizing the Ministry to collect the levy as a part of the Provincial Tax Billing match the information on the assessment roll.

NOW THEREFORE The Local Services Board of Nolalu enacts as follows:

1. THAT Methodology 1 in OPTA – a flat fee per property - is the method of calculation to be used for the 2016-2017 fiscal year tax levy for a total levy of \$94,935 billed as \$145 per eligible property to be dispersed as follows: \$75.67 Fire Protection Services; \$41.38 Recreation Services; and \$27.95 Administration.
2. THAT the Local Services Board of Nolalu hereby authorizes the Minister of Finance to bill and collect the levy as a part of the 2017 Provincial Land Tax Billing on behalf of the Local Services Board of Nolalu.
3. THAT By-law 2016-13 is repealed.

Being a by-law to support Ontario Regulation 103/17, a regulation amending Ontario Regulation 737 to exclude a property from the jurisdiction of the Local Services Board of Nolalu.

WHEREAS the Local Services Board of Nolalu (Nolalu LSB) submitted a proposal to the Minister of Northern Development and Mines in 2015 to correct an error made in the enactment of Ontario Regulation 240/08, under the *Northern Services Board Act*, whereby a property was excluded from the listed exceptions in the Geographic Township of Marks; and

WHEREAS through the legislated public process, inhabitants of both the current LSB area and the property to be excluded voted to move forward with this request to the Minister of Northern Development and Mines to alter the LSB's boundary to exclude the property legally described as CON 7 S PT LOT 10 PCL 1124 FWF MARKS TWP; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Northern Development and Mines has filed Ontario Regulation 103/17 on April 13, 2017 to amended Regulation 737 made under the *Northern Services Board Act* to exclude the subject property from the LSB's jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE the Local Services Board of Nolalu enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Board hereby supports Ontario Regulation 103/17 amending Ontario Regulation 737 made under the *Northern Services Board Act* to exclude the property legally described CON 7 S PT LOT 10 PCL 1124 FWF MARKS TWP from the jurisdiction of the Local Services Board of Nolalu.
